Press Release – Continuing GOOD NEWS for Cannington

The extensive schedule of refurbishment works is now nearing completion and some regular user groups are back in the Village Hall. The works that have been completed is the installation of an enhanced heating system, new kitchen and toilet facilities for both the upstairs and downstairs halls, upgraded doubling glazing, solar panels for the roof, new flooring in the lower hall and complete redecoration of the building.

On Sunday 10th July, an Open Afternoon and Tea Party will be held to allow Cannington residents and other interested parties to view the newly refurbished Village Hall and meet some of the groups that regularly use the Hall.

The refurbishment has been completely funded by The Hinkley Point C Community Impact Mitigation Fund. This Fund was negotiated with EDF Energy as part of a wider mitigation package for the site preparation works at Hinkley Point. £7.2million has been made available to fund community projects such as this with the aim of promoting or improving the social, economic or environmental well-being of the local communities most affected by the development at Hinkley Point C.

When the refurbishment is complete, the Hall will be available for bookings and there will be time slots available mornings, afternoons and some evenings. For further information, please contact Rose on 01278 652102.
