



Hinkley Point C Look ahead

July 2019



We continually monitor the light, noise and dust emissions from Hinkley Point C Site to ensure that our construction works have a minimal impact. However, you may still see and hear some aspects of the work. This is a summary of some of our current works:

Location		Description of works
1	Southern Landscape Area	Reseeding of the Southern Landscape Area to improve biodiversity is ongoing.
2	Materials Stockpiles	Processing of materials and stockpiling of the remaining material being excavated continues.
3	Unit 1	Following completion of the J0 concrete pour, construction of the reactor building, above the foundation level, will commence.
4	Unit 2	Excavation and preparation of the foundations for the Unit 2 area is almost complete. After this, construction of the Pre-Stressing Gallery walls and roof slabs will continue.
5	Jetty	Vessels will arrive at the jetty in July as part of a programme of training exercises.
6	Construction Area	The Sarens SGC250 crane is currently being assembled. It will be the tallest crane on site throughout the entire construction period and will perform some of the heaviest lifts.
	Off-site – Comwich Wharf	Dredging and delivery of the Tunnel Boring Machine components was successfully completed in June. Preparation works for the renovation of the wharf are continuing.
