#### **WEATHER UPDATE**

January temperatures were a little above the average [8.6c maximum and 2.3c minimum] We recorded thirteen air frosts which is twice the average. The lowest was -4.4c on the 21st. Rainfall was 37.2mm which is about half the average. 17mm of this total fell on the last four days when the barometer fell to the lowest of the month.



February continued the trend set by January's weather in being warmer than average [9.8c maximum and 4.3c minimum] This was brought about by a dominant west wind. There were just four air frosts. Rainfall at 42.4mm was about 80% of the average. A very dry spell from the 8th to the 23rd finished with 9.4mm on the 24th. This was because of a visit from named storm Doris which also brought the strongest winds of the month at 44mph. Winter ends at the end of February for the meteorologists and we can say we've experienced a milder and very much drier winter than for some years. 9.67c and 3.1c were maximum and minimum averages about one degree above the long term figures while the 136mm was only 65% of the norm.

March lived up to the phrase "in like a lion and out like a lamb" The first week brought us 17mm of rain with some very strong south westerly winds. The highest speed was 41mph on the 5th. With the exception of a depression bringing heavy rain from the 21st to the 23rd March brought some fine spring weather. Maximum and minimum averages of 12.9c and 5.8c were higher than normal. The 34.4mm of rain was well below the average.



#### **QUANTOCK DEANERY MISSION PROJECT 2017**

Every year, the churches of the Quantock Deanery, including St Mary's, Cannington, adopt a charity for which they raise money. Often these are small charities where our contribution can make a real difference. This year, our charity is the Kathryn Mercy Home Trust.

The Trust, which comprises a school and Joan's Grace Home, a hostel for girls, is the brain child of Rev Jeyapaul, a priest in the Church of South India. The hostel provides accommodation for young girls from impoverished rural villages in Tamil Nadu, one of the poorest states of South India, in order that they can attend secondary school, and access further education in the town of Devakottai.

The education of girls enables them to break the cycle of poverty which for generations has meant that early marriage, motherhood and manual labour have been all that the future holds



The Mercy Home Trust relies solely on the generosity of sponsors and donors from the UK and is transforming the future of the girls and their families. The launch of the project in January at St Peter's Church, Williton raised £190, a truly magnificent start to the year. All the money we raise this year will go towards purchasing a minibus so that the girls can travel safely to school, rather than risking life and limb walking beside a busy dual carriageway with no pavement while avoiding the vagaries of Indian driving skills! Please keep an eye out for any events and stalls that St Mary's will be running during 2017 to raise money towards buying this much needed minibus. 

#### **Notes from your County Councillor**

<u>Park and Ride Scheme</u> Following a presentation by EDF to the Parish Council it seems that construction will commence in June and take about a year to complete. During that period, the contractors will work normal hours and we are assured that disruption will be kept to a minimum. We await more information about working hours once the facility is operational.

Around 250 vehicles spaces are to be provided on the site which will be in a field on the village side of the old by pass. Access will be from the right hand of the Carriageway only with traffic from Bridgwater having to use the Western Roundabout and return down the road. Traffic from the site will then use the Eastern roundabout to travel to Hinkley Point. There will be 24-hour security on site throughout.

<u>Village Archive</u> Over the years, I have collected quite an amount of pictorial and written information about Cannington and the Parish Council have kindly agreed to act as custodians and store this in the Parish Office.

If any villagers have historic items or photographs that can be copied they would make welcome additions to the collection for future generations to peruse and research.

<u>Cannington in Bloom</u> The volunteers whose work continues to be impressive have provided a wonderful colourful display along the Jubilee Gardens railings. There have been many expressions of support and praise on the 'Cannington Now' website. The team should be assured of the wholehearted support of the village and with more volunteers who knows what might be achieved this year!

Thank you all so much for what you do to enhance our village.

<u>LAST POST</u> This will be my final Target contribution as I am not seeking re-election in the County Council Elections on the 4<sup>th</sup> May. Having served for four terms it is high time a younger person took over.







<u>Practice Manager.</u> In March this year, we sadly said goodbye to our Practice Manager, Carol Woodward, who left to return to her Northern roots. Carol has enjoyed her time in Somerset, but will be moving back closer to her daughters and grandchildren.

The Nursing Team. The nursing team continue to strive to meet the needs of our patients and we thank you for your patience and flexibility when we have to juggle your appointments or occasionally run late. Laura the Health Care Assistant, is running very successful phlebotomy clinics. These are for blood tests only, for that reason the appointments are just 5 minutes. If you need something else such as a blood pressure check, the receptionists will be very pleased to book that appointment separately for you.

Amongst many other skills, Laura continues with her invaluable support for those with long term conditions e.g. chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and diabetes.

Jane one of the Practice Nurses who joined us 2 years ago is an experienced nurse and a great asset to the team in many ways. She is training to complete a diploma in COPD at a University in Bristol in order to become more involved with this condition soon.

Many of you will already know Liz Browne, an experienced Practice Nurse as she has done many locum sessions for us in the past. We are delighted that she has agreed to join us on a more permanent basis which makes our team now complete.

We are always looking at ways to improve our service and welcome your ideas. Thanks again for making our jobs so rewarding!

<u>Hayfever.</u> It is the time of year when hayfever symptoms are starting. Symptoms can be similar to a cold, and include a runny nose, watery eyes and repeated sneezing attacks — Did you know you don't need to see the doctor for hayfever symptoms? Community pharmacists can offer advice on how to avoid triggers and how to treat hayfever. A prescription is not needed for hayfever medicines. Many treatments are available at little cost from a pharmacy or supermarket.

Minor Ailments. The pharmacist can help you with many minor ailments such as mild eczema, coughs and colds, indigestion and athlete's foot. You can visit the pharmacy at any time with common health problems, saving yourself the time and trouble of waiting for a GP appointment. If your problem is more serious and needs the attention of a GP, the pharmacist will recognize this and advise you to see your GP instead.

<u>Prescription Charges.</u> On 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017 the NHS prescription charge was increased to £8.60 for each medicine or appliance dispensed.

Reduce Medicines Waste. In an attempt to reduce the estimated £3Million pounds of medicines waste in Somerset per year, the Health Centre are in support of this year's medicine waste campaign. Medicines waste is an issue where everyone has a part to play, we would encourage patients to only order what medication they need and to check your prescription bag before you leave the practice dispensary or local pharmacy and return any unwanted medicines.



<u>Urgent medication requests.</u> Our dispensers have noticed an increase in the number of 'urgent' medication requests. Whilst our dispensers will always try and accommodate urgent requests, this is not always possible and we may not be able to have the prescription ready for collection on the same day. Please order your repeat medication in advance so that you do not run out. Once ordered, please allow at least 48 hours (excluding weekends).

<u>Prescription Line.</u> Repeat medication can be ordered by calling our dedicated prescription line on 01278 651311. This line is open between 9.30am to 12 noon Monday – Friday.

Ordering medication and making appointments online — available to use 24/7. Did you know that you can order your repeat medication & book appointments online? To do this, you will need to register for a Patient Access account. Please bring some ID (e.g. passport/driving licence/ utility bill) and see a receptionist who will be able to give you your log in details within a few minutes.

SMS Text Service. We have recently enabled SMS text service for appointments. A short text message will be sent to your mobile phone shortly after you book an appointment. A further message will be sent 2 days before your appointment is due to remind you. The receptionist making your appointment should check that we hold your current mobile number.


most part over the year there are a lot more people and groups coming together for the greater good of the village.

### **Parish Council Precept**

The Parish Council has kept the precept at £40,000 for the sixth year in succession. You will however have noticed a small increase on your council tax demand which is due to the reduction in Government funding. It has only been possible to keep the precept at the same level due to the additional income received from EDF for the rent of Rodway Playing Field car park.

### Village Maintenance

The Parish Council has greatly increased its budget for this financial year. We are paying SDC Clean Surrounds to double the number of times the highways grass is cut around the village. We will also be assisting Cannington in Bloom this year in the forthcoming regional and national competitions including watering the planters and barrier baskets and targeting specific areas that need more attention around the village.

### **Southbrook Housing Development**

The Parish Council has made a formal complaint to SDC Planning Department regarding irregularities with the planning consent and we are awaiting a response.

### **Youth Club**

As reported in the last Target the Parish Council took over the management of the Youth Club in January however it hasn't been possible for us to continue. We are in the process of setting up an agreement with Youth Unlimited to manage the Youth Club on our behalf. It is hoped that the Youth Club will resume on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2017.

### **Traffic Calming**

The Parish Council met with SCC in February 2017 who will complete a feasibility study and have been given a free hand to come up with suitable traffic calming measures for Cannington. We hope to have a report on their study shortly.

### Dog bins

The dog bin at the junction of Chads Hill and Park Lane has been removed and placed where the path from Sandy Lane meets Brymore Way.

### **Allotments**


