

### **Tribute to Father Peter**

On Monday May 11<sup>th</sup> Fr Peter will conduct his final service after 27 years ministry in Cannington and the neighbouring villages.

Despite several illnesses, some very serious over the years Fr Peter has always bounced back and now looks forward to many years of happy retirement in Minehead near his beloved West Somerset Railway.

Fr Peter was brought up with brother Geoff in Datchet in the shadow of Windsor Castle and Eton College. Following school he entered local government and became a housing officer. He worked in some of the poorer parts of London before a move to North Dorset where he became head of the housing department.

In his early 30's he was called to the ministry, trained at Lincoln Theological College and following short spells in Taunton and Bath came to Cannington in 1988. He quickly became a familiar figure and immersed himself in village life. There are very few families in this village who have not come in contact with Fr Peter both in sad and happy times. He has managed to tread that difficult path of avoiding controversy and has been awarded various Diocesan posts including at times, Prebendary of Wells Cathedral Archdeaconry, Warden of Readers, Rural Dean of Sedgemoor and Quantock Deaneries. Chairman of Trustees of the Abbey House, Glastonbury – the Diocesan Retreat House. He has continued his interest in housing and for two years was Chairman of Taunton Association for the Homeless and founding Chairman of SHAL Housing Association for 11 years

His main legacy will be the condition of the Parish Church which he has nurtured and kept in excellent order with the help of many willing workers.

We will all very much miss his cheerful face, ready sense of humour and a 'can do' philosophy in all things he has undertaken.

God Bless you Peter and we thank you for your outstanding ministry.

### **Cannington Flower Show – 2015**

This years Show will be held on Saturday 22nd August at Cannington Church of England Primary School. Please look out for schedules which should be around the village during July. We made a lot of changes last year to the classes so the Committee have decided to leave the classes the same for 2015. So.... please start your upcycling now as that could be a bigger project.

Remember we had furniture last year so everything would be welcome! Cannington Flower Show is an open show so is as that suggests **open to all**.

You do not have to live in Cannington to enter a class. Some of the trophies are reserved for Cannington residents, but please don't let that stop you from entering a class if you live outside the village because all First, Second and Third prizes can be won by anyone, living anywhere if your entry is considered the best by the judge.

The children's classes are divided into age groups and there are lots of things to make or grow to enter. Again, children can enter wherever they live, so if anyone has visitors this summer and need to entertain the children on a rainy day make something for the Flower Show. The entrant doesn't have to be there on the day of the show so long as someone can stage the exhibit for them.

We handed over the administration of the village Front Garden Competition to Cannington in Bloom last year. This seemed to fit better with their work in improving the look of the village, but the presentation of prizes remained at the Flower Show. Members of Cannington in Bloom are also helping us with the Show by being the drop off point for trophies and entry forms. This help is greatly appreciated, especially as none of the Flower Show officers live in the centre of Cannington.

We do have a Facebook page called "Cannington Flower Show" and we get to hear about any posts on the Cannington Now page too. We will try to set a link to this year's Schedule once it is available. If anyone would like a schedule e-mailed this can also be done – please let us know your Email address via the Facebook page or ring me. The schedule isn't quite finished yet, so please be patient.

We have managed to keep the Show on the village calendar since its restart in the 1980's and we'd like to keep it there a few years longer. If anyone reading this article is interested in joining the committee, or has a little time to help out on show day, please get in touch.







I am sure you will agree that the barrier baskets along the Jubilee Gardens looked absolutely amazing. I am never quite sure if our selection of plants and colours will work but I shouldn't have worried as they have been full to bursting and the scent from the blue and yellow Hyacinths has just been delightful. The baskets were planted by the students from **Bridgwater College Cannington Centre** under the watchful eye of Jayne Alcock who is also a member of CiB. Well done team.

The summer barrier baskets will be going out in June. All the plants have been grown from seed by **Brymore Students** and CiB will maintain them throughout the summer months. # **WEATHER UPDATE**

January's weather was dominated by westerly winds so making it slightly warmer than the average. Maximum and minimum averages were 9.6c and 2.6c. Rainfall at 65.3mm was 87% of the average. Temperatures during the first half of the month were well above the expected with a recording of 15.6c on the 9th. The month concluded with hail storms and blustery winds the highest wind speed being 38mph on the 28th.

**February** was a month of two halves. Up to the 13th it was colder and drier with seven air frosts and only 1mm of rain. After midmonth a series of low pressure systems brought wetter, milder and windier weather. An average maximum [7.9c] and average minimum [1.9c] were just below the average, while the 32.2mm of rain we recorded was 62% of the average.

**Winter 2014-15** was slightly warmer. The 17 air frosts recorded were 8 fewer than average. Rainfall at 133mm was only 63% of the norm. Do you remember last winter? Only 3 air frosts and over twice the average rain.

**March** began with some strong winds [30 -35mph gusts] and some frontal rain, then pressure built and we experienced a quiet and largely dry three weeks. However there was a sting in the tail and March did not go out like a lamb. We recorded winds of 35mph to 45mph during the last three days concluding with one of 55mph at 04.00am on the morning of the 31st. This is the highest for several years. Maximum and minimum temperature averages [10.8c and 3.66] were about the norm. There were no air frosts and the rainfall at 29mm was just over half the average.

### CANNINGTON PARISH COUNCIL

This will be the last submission from the current Parish Council before the May 2015 elections. The Parish elections will be uncontested as only nine nominations were received for the ten councillor positions. Current Councillors who decided not to stand for re-election are Mrs Lynda Laird, Mrs Sheila Allen, Mrs Sarah Jansons, Mr Brian Stother and Mr Lawrence Greenslade.



As from May the Council will consist of Mr Colin Allen, Mr Mike Phillips, Mr Alan Davey, Mr David Greenslade, Mr Alan Beasley, Mr Robert Morgan, Mr Robin Phipps, Mr Jack Popham and Mr Andrew Vickery. An additional Councillor will be co-opted at a later date.

Our current Chairman, Colin Allen has produced a report on the last four years of the Parish Council:-

EDF has dominated the work of the Parish Council with the numerous public consultations and IPC consultations on the planning application for Hinkley Point C, transport forum and community forum meetings, development of Cannington Court and monthly updates with the Cannington Bypass.

Flooding has also been a major issue with a number of properties being flooded in the Northbrook Area. The Parish Council has set up an Emergency Flood Committee and has a flood store in Northbrook stocked with sand, sand bags and a water pump. The Council co-ordinated with various Authorities to get the drains cleared. We are currently supporting the Environment Agency with the proposed Flood Alleviation Scheme for which a planning application has now been submitted.

Over the last 4 years the Council has dealt with numerous planning applications and in particular the 16 properties to the East of Main Road. The S106 agreement is being completed for the open green space to be given to the Council along with a commuted sum of £50,000 for future maintenance. There will also be a £150,000 contribution to the Flood Alleviation Scheme.

The Cemetery has seen a new path installed and the old hedge at the front of the Cemetery removed and a new hedge planted. Both the bus shelters have been refurbished and a defibrillator installed on the High Street Bus Shelter. The Playing Field Pavilion has had new doors and windows installed and the car park refurbished. We have received over £20,000 from renting the car park first to Magnox (Hinkley Point A) and currently to Kier Construction the contractors for Cannington Court. We have installed grit bins and additional dog bins throughout the village.

The Black Poplar in the Jubilee Gardens has been cut down to a safe height. It caused a great deal of interest to many people as it was taken down in sections using a large crane. Numerous photographs were taken for our archives. We hope to establish the age of the tree in the near future.

A Steering Group was set up for the S106 Mitigation from EDF of £500,000. After various meetings and public consultations a wish list was agreed. One of the main items was for better play facilities and the Park in Brook Street is currently undergoing a major face lift. We are currently negotiating with SDC to purchase the Rodway Playing Field.





### **CANNINGTON PARISH COUNCIL**

The Youth Club in the village hall is now in its third year and is growing strong. The Council supports the club along with grants from SCC.

There have been a number of Highways issues in particular the number of accidents and an unfortunate fatality along Brook Street and an anti-skid surface has been recently installed. A Traffic Calming consultation has recently taken place in the village and the report has been sent to SCC; we are waiting their response.

A steering group has been set up to develop a Neighbourhood Plan. Information has been gathered from residents from Open days and various questionnaires including online questionnaires. The information is now being collated and the information gathered will used to produce the plan.

I would like to thank all the Parish Councillors, District Councillors Ann Bown and Ian Dyer and County Councillor John Edney for their contribution and support over the last four years.

We must not forget the tragic deaths of Maurice Locke and Roger Nurton and the valuable contributions they made to the Council.




