- Most active Watch areas see a reduction in crime and increase in the sense of community spirit and well being

#### **HOW DO I SET UP A SCHEME?**

Setting up a scheme is easy, simply contact Lindsey Stone in the Watch Schemes Office, Bridgwater Police Centre, Phone 01278-644799 during office hours (Mon-Fri 8.00am-4.00pm) or Email on: <a href="mailto:lindsey.stone@avonandsomerset.police.uk">lindsey.stone@avonandsomerset.police.uk</a>

Lindsey will be able to give you pack of information about Neighbourhood Watch which you can read at your leisure.

The pack will ask you to complete a survey of your immediate area to see if there is sufficient interest to start a scheme. The recommended size of a scheme is 10-20 properties.

If there is sufficient interest, then arrangements are made with local beat staff to meet with you and your neighbours.

The volunteer co-ordinator(s)/deputy complete the necessary registration forms and when returned to the office records are completed and the scheme formally registered.
