Map Ref.	Location	What's occurring?
1	Batching Plant & Jetty	Assembly of the fourth concrete batching plant due to start in May. Aggregate deliveries by sea will commence shortly.
2	MARR crane	The world's largest crane in its class is continuing to support mobilisation of the Tunnel Boring Machines. Following complaints relating to the lights on the crane jib, they have now been changed for downward facing lights.
3	Southern Landscape	Final tree planting and drainage works are ongoing.
4	Earthworks	Earthworks continue, including stockpiling and processing of material. Night shift activities to conclude shortly.
5	Sea wall	Works taking place to install recurve wall segments to support the final stages of sea wall construction.
6	National Grid (NG) Yard	The platform has now been fully handed over to National Grid to construct Shurton Substation.
Off Site	Combwich Wharf	Early works and initial contractor set up
