Weather Report

July - certainly broke records for rainfall, or more accurately lack of it. We recorded only 3mm, and that on one day, the 2nd. This with some very high temperatures shrivelled many plants and turned green areas brown. After seven months the annual rainfall is 167mm in deficit. Three



days saw the thermometer rise to over 30c, the highest being 34.4c on the 18th. This was fractionally less than we recorded in August 2020 and very much less than in many other parts of the country. Overall day time temperatures were not surprisingly three degrees above average at 24.6c and night time about half a degree higher at 13.5c



August - continued the very hot and dry weather of the previous month. We saw the temperature rise above 30c for six consecutive days [9th to the 14th] the highest was 35.3c on the 13th so it is no surprise to see an average monthly maximum some five degrees higher at 26,3c. Night time temperatures averaged 13.4c. Rainfall was very low at 22mm and 20mm of that fell on the 15th and 16th when a low pressure system passed quickly through. Annual rainfall to date is 241mm, just about half

of what we **might** have expected by now.

September - was a much more normal month, meteorologically speaking, than earlier months. The day and night averages of 20.5c and 11.9c were about a degree above average whilst the rainfall of 55mm, most of which fell in the first half of the month, was only a couple of millimetres below average. The annual total to date of 297mm is still some 200mm in deficit. **David Daggar**



Cannington Health Centre - Dispensary

You may be aware of marketing of online pharmacy services. Many of these companies appear in NHS digital mobile phone applications, websites as one option to supply your prescribed medicines and via post. While you can choose to use any dispensary to supply your prescription medicines, there are a few considerations when using online pharmacies:

- You cannot have any face-to-face contact with an on-line pharmacy. They can only deal with patients by post, telephone or internet, not in person.
- Your prescription will be delivered by Royal Mail, unlike your medications handed to you in the dispensary by a member of our team.
- In October 2015, an online pharmacy business was fined £130,000 for selling its patients' details to marketing companies.
- In February 2017, the Care Quality Commission inspected an online pharmacy business and found that it was "not safe, effective or well led".

An internet pharmacy business is no substitute for your local dispensary.

We have several options with how you can order your prescriptions. Unfortunately, we are unable to dispense to you if you live within a mile of a pharmacy (as the crow flies)

- You can order your prescriptions for collection from the surgery via the online NHS app (please contact the surgery for information).
- We have a dedicated repeat prescription line which is open between 9.30am – 12pm Monday-Friday 01278 655 464 which is operated by a dispenser who will be able to help with any queries you may have.
- You can drop off your repeat slip at any time.

We aim to complete prescription orders with 72 working hours, and we will contact you if there is a supply problem with any medication.

Please support us to continue caring for you and your family by ignoring any correspondence from an online pharmacy business, and by continuing to obtain your prescriptions here at your local NHS dispensary.

Flu vaccinations

Flu vaccinations are well underway, if you are eligible to receive a free flu vaccine, please phone 01278 652335 and book an appointment. Where possible, we ask that you phone after 2pm.

Please note, we are unable to offer COVID boosters at the practice, to book for a COVID vaccination, please call 119.

This year's recipient was born in Cannington, married, raised children and still lives and works in Cannington - a true local

In any emergency, he was always on hand, during the floods in 2012, working in terrible conditions to save the village from flooding and making trees safe in a storm. Always one of the first to volunteer, helping with the Christmas lights, providing manpower and machinery from his business and carrying out enhancements in the village free of charge, and much more.

As with many parents, you tend to get drawn into your children's activities by helping out now and then, but this person did more than just help out and became a scout leader, not just while his children were involved, but long after. His involvement only ceased when Covid brought an untimely end to the scout group.

On a lighter note, you may remember that he played James Bond in one of the village pantomimes.

This years Child of Cannington Award goes to the very worthy recipient, David Greenslade, someone you can rely on.







People aged 50 years and older, residents in care homes for older people, those aged 5 years and over in a clinical risk group and health and social care staff will be offered a booster of coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine this autumn. Appointments will be available from the National Booking Service shortly.

Who is being offered an autumn booster?

COVID-19 is more serious in older people and in people with certain underlying health conditions. This winter it is expected that many respiratory infections, including COVID-19 and flu may be circulating at high levels – this may put increasing pressure on hospitals and other health care services. For these reasons, people aged 50 years and over, those in care homes, and those aged 5 years and over in clinical risk groups are being offered an autumn booster of COVID-19 vaccine. A booster will also be offered to front-line health

and social care staff, those who care for vulnerable individuals and families of individuals with weakened immune systems.

The autumn booster is being offered to those at high risk of the complications of COVID-19 infection, who may have not been boosted for a few months.

As the number of COVID-19 infections increases over the winter, this booster should help to reduce your risk of being admitted to hospital with COVID-19.

The booster may also provide some protection against mild Omicron infection but such protection does not last for long.



The ringers were honoured to be able to pay tribute to our late Queen in September. We were able to ring solidly for an hour, along with many other towers in the country, on the Friday, the day after

her death. You may have noticed a more muted sound, this is because the bells were half muffled, we also flew our flag at half-mast. If you noticed a more jubilant ring on non-muffled bells the next day (Saturday) this was because we were ringing for the official proclamation of the new King, Charles III. The flag was raised for this occasion and then lowered to half mast again the following day for the period of mourning leading up to the funeral. On the day of the funeral, we rang, still half-muffled, for the hour preceding the funeral. As a tower we are sent very specific instructions to follow from the diocese so that we know what we need to do on occasions such as this. Of course, it isn't always possible to follow everything to the letter as all towers rely on the availability of ringers but at Cannington, we managed to fulfil the requirements and were all pleased to have played our part.

Hinkley Point B Power Station Decommissioning Consultation

As you are aware, Hinkley Point B stopped generating electricity in August 2022 after 46 years of service. Over the next few years, EDF will be working closely with the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority and Magnox to develop proposals for decommissioning. Decommissioning will involve dismantling and demolition of plant and buildings on the Hinkley Point B site.



Cathy's Gardening Tips

November - slow time of year for gardening, time for planning, not too much tidying up so that the insects and wildlife, hedgehogs and butterflies can overwinter in the long grass, leaves, hedges and spent plants. Up to January the weather is not too wet or frosty and is perfect for digging deep holes for new clematis and roses. Add plenty of well-rotted manure, compost, grit or sharp sand and soil. Leave a dustbin lid size dip when levelling the soil. Tread down gently to protect the soil structure.



On the allotment, raised bed or window ledge, sow seeds of cabbage, chard, cauliflower, calabrese, spinach, leafy salads, lettuce and even annuals ready for next year. Keep in a greenhouse, cold frame or cloche to over winter until spring. Eat some of the vegetables as mini leaves.

December - again in suitable weather winter pots can be planted out with ivy, holly, skimmia and anything with berries. Other pots can be planted up with a 'lasagne' of spring flowering bulbs, giving you flowers from February onwards, Mulch raspberries.

Cover tender plants with horticultural fleece. Draw up your cropping plan: **Year 1,** legumes, onions, roots, next brassicas, lastly potatoes. **Year 2,** brassicas then

potatoes, lastly legumes, onions, roots. **Year 3**, potatoes, next legumes, onions, roots, lastly brassicas interplant with wildflowers for nectar loving insects.

January - place your seed orders. Prune dead, dying, damaged, diseased wood and any crossing inwards and rubbing other branches. Leave pruning of stone fruit until spring and summer. Try not to walk on your lawn when it is frosty as this damages the growth.


Bridgwater Choral Society were due to celebrate 70 years after their reformation after World War II, but all the celebrations were stopped by Covid-19.

Is your child living with another family?

Have you been looking after someone else's child for 28 days or more?

Do you know a child that's being looked after outside their close family?

If so, the child may be living in a private fostering arrangement.

The law says you must tell Children's Social Care if you know about any private fostering arrangements. This is so we can make sure the children are well looked after and to give support to their carers.

What is private fostering?

Private fostering is when a child or young person under 16 years old - or under 18 if they have a disability - lives with someone for 28 days or more who is not a close relative, guardian or person with parental responsibility. A close relative would be a parent, step-parent, aunt, uncle or grandparent.

People become private foster carers for all sorts of reasons. They might be a friend of the child's family. They could be someone who is willing to look after a child they do not know, for example if that child is on an exchange trip or have parents who live overseas.

If Children's Social Care has made the arrangement, or the person who is caring for the child is and approved foster carer, this is not private fostering.

What to do if you know of a private fostering arrangement

The law says you must tell Children's Social Care if you know about any private fostering arrangements.

If you think you are privately fostering a child or know about a child who is being privately fostered, then don't worry, it is allowed. But you do need to tell us - we have a legal duty to ensure that all children who are privately fostered are cared for in a safe and suitable environment.



Blueberry Cheese cake

900 g cream cheese

200 g demerara sugar

4 large eggs plus one yolk

2 teaspoon of vanilla bean paste

200 g crème fraiche

Zest and juice of one lemon

Serves 8-10 about 500 calories per portion.

Sauce

100 ml water

100 ml sugar

300 g blueberries

3 tsp cornflour mixed with 1tbs water base

Base

250 g digestive biscuits

120 g butter or vegan spread

Crush biscuits wrapped in a clean towel with a rolling pin or put in your food processor and whizz until crumbs. Melt butter in large non-stick pan, turn off heat and mix in crumbs. Put into a 20cm (8") spring release cake tin lined with non-stick parchment, press the mixture into the bottom using your knuckles. Separate eggs and whisk egg whites until fluffy, add egg yolks and then mix in all cheese cake ingredients.

Pour over biscuit base and place spring form cake tin into an empty roasting tin. Put in low shelf of oven at 180 degrees C/ Gas 4 for 1 hour to bake lightly. Turn off oven and leave door ajar to cool.

Put all sauce ingredients into a non-stick saucepan heat on medium stirring all the time until thickened. Spoon fruit sauce over separately.

A bit fiddly to make but well worth it.




